 3. Take Exit 24 (formerly Exit 20) for Burncoat St/Lincoln St.
 4. Follow the signs for Lincoln Street.
 5. Turn right onto Lincoln Street.
 6. The destination, 299 Lincoln Street, will be on your left.
- From the South (via I-290 W)
 1. Take I-290 W toward Worcester.
 2. Take Exit 24 (formerly Exit 20) for Lincoln St/Burncoat St.
 3. Keep left at the fork and follow signs for Lincoln Street.
 4. Turn left onto Lincoln Street.
 5. The destination, 299 Lincoln Street, will be on your left.
